Ph.D. Admission Procedure for International Candidates

1. General Eligibility for Admission:

1.1. The eligibility for admission into Ph.D. programmes is PG degree of the Institution or any other qualification recognized as equivalent thereto in the field of study as notified in the Table A below.

Ph.D Degree in Law	M.L in the relevant branch of Law or equivalence degree specified by AIU.

1.2 The programme on which the eligibility is to be relied upon must be from an Institute included a list of the Association of Indian Universities (AIU), New Delhi – 110002 (<http://www.aiuweb.org>)

1.3 In case the University / Board is not included in the said list, the candidate has to obtain and submit an equivalence certificate to this effect from the Association of Indian Universities

2. Programmes Offered

2.1. The Institution offers the following Programmes leading to the award of Ph.D. degree

- i. Engineering
- ii. Technology
- iii. Business Administration

iv. Computer Applications

v. Science & Humanities

vi. Law

2.2. The specializations offered in each of these programmes shall be listed in the Institution website from time to time.

2.3. The programmes may change or vary as may be decided by the Institution Research Board from time to time.

3. Modes of Ph.D. Programme

The programmes may be offered in Full Time mode of study

3.1. Full Time Ph.D. Programme

3.1.1. Candidates under full-time shall do research work in the Institution and shall be available during the working hours for curricular, co-curricular and related activities.

3.1.2. Candidates in employment who want to pursue full-time studies should be sponsored by their employer and should avail leave for the research period and should get formally relieved from their duty to join the research programme.

3.1.3. Candidates who are sponsored by the AICTE under Quality Improvement Programme from Teachers of Engineering Colleges and who satisfy the eligibility conditions shall be eligible for full-time only, in the disciplines as notified in AICTE guidelines.

3.1.4. Candidates who are selected in Fellowship programme of National or any recognized bodies and who satisfy the eligibility conditions as per the regulations are eligible for full-time studies in the respective disciplines.

3.1.5. Foreign nationals sponsored by the Government of India on any exchange programme and who satisfy the eligibility conditions as per the regulations are eligible for full – time study

3.1.6. The scholars who are receiving financial assistance from the institution have to take teaching assistance work, if assigned.

4. Mode of Selection

The preliminary scrutiny will be done by the Office of the Dean Research Studies and followed by Scrutiny Committee Members and also short list the eligible candidates as per norms. The short listed candidates shall be called for Interview.

4.1 Candidate seeking Ph.D admission can apply through online application available in Institution Portal.

4.2 English Translations of all transcripts, duly attested, are to be submitted

4.3 Candidate shall submit the proposed research work clearly indicating the problem to be studied, prevailing research going on around the world in that area, gaps identified in the current research work, scope of the proposed work and references. This write up is required for the department to assess the suitability for the research program.

- 4.4 The proposal of the research work will be assessed by the Departmental Research Committee (DRC) of the concerned department. The DRC, may call for a video/ teleconference to assess the candidate's technical knowledge, communication skills and research capacity.
- 4.5 If needed Online Examination will be conducted by the controller of Examination as a part of assessment. The DRC will identify a supervisor to guide the candidate on his / her research work and based on its recommendation, the Dean, Research studies will issue the Provisional Admission Letter through Director International Relations.
- 4.6 The tuition and other applicable fees mentioned in the Provisional Admission Letter have to be paid within 10 days from the date of provisional admission.
- 4.7 On being granted admission, the applicant must produce the student visa within one month of completion of admission formalities. In case of failure to obtain a visa within a stipulated period the admission stands cancelled. A copy of this visa is to be submitted in the office of the Director, International Relations.
- 4.8 Upon arrival in India, every foreign research scholars must register with a Foreigners Regional Registration Office (FRRO).
- 4.9 The Institute will be providing Scholarship / Stipend to the Full Time Research scholars who seek admission in International Admission Quota.
- 4.10 The medium of the instruction of the Ph.D course work and the language of the thesis shall be English.
- 4.11 The interview / viva-voce shall also consider the following aspects, viz whether;
- 4.11.1. The candidate possess the competence for the proposed research;
- 4.11.2. The research work can be suitably undertaken at the Institution;
- 4.11.3. The proposed area of research can contribute to new/additional knowledge.
- 4.12. Selected candidates shall be provisionally admitted for Ph.D. programme with the approval of the Vice-Chancellor on verification of original certificates and payment of prescribed fee.
- 4.13. Admission into Ph.D. Programme will be made in accordance with the existing and applicable reservation rules in force.
- 4.14. The list of registered candidates with particulars of their topic of research, supervisor, and date of enrollment / registration will be placed in Institution website.
